The coaching profession and the International Coach Federation (ICF) have grown tremendously the last 14 years from 2100 in 1999 to an estimated 47,000 in 2012.

- Approximately 47,000 members worldwide
- 117 chapters in 50 countries
- 45 chapters in the US
- Over 12,000 members in the US
- Average annual income is \$47,900*
- Average hourly fee is \$130 \$320* depending on type of coaching and the coach's experience
- Average number of clients is 10*
- 67% of coaches are women*
